The other remedy range that I find hugely helpful for animals are the Tissue Salts. These are little white pills that contain natural body chemicals. They are pretty tasteless and dogs and horses just gobble them down. Of course cats are a different matter but, in my experience, I have found that they accept the Tissue Salts pretty well if mixed into their food or dissolved in a bit of water and given straight into their mouths.

There are 12 Tissue Salts in total and the only one to be used with caution is Tissue Salt No.12 – Silicia, which may not be given if an animal has had any surgical implant.

None of these remedies are to replace the medication prescribed by your Veterinarian but can be used in conjunction with or as a prophylactic, thereby helping your animal to avoid dis-eases.
